(Very important: This \$50.00 fee entitles you to lifetime membership in Phi Alpha Theta and in our Beta Pi Chapter. It also gives you a free one-year subscription to THE HISTORIAN. If you attend another school for graduate work and wish to participate in chapter activities there, you may be asked to "update" your membership with a one-time local dues payment (currently about \$10) to that chapter. But otherwise, you are never required to pay membership dues to Phi Alpha Theta again. Any subsequent literature you get months from the time you first join is either going to ask if you wish to re-subscribe to THE HISTORIAN (beyond your first free year) or if you would like to pay "sustaining membership dues," but you are not required to pay any of these. They are totally optional, the latter being, of course, for those members who would like to make further donations to the good work Phi Alpha Theta does. Please remember these distinctions so you will not get confused when you get a mailing from Phi Alpha Theta about a year from now that seems to be asking you for additional money. It is, in a sense, but deciding not to renew the journal or deciding not to be a donor in no way interrupts your lifetime membership.)

If everything in your application is in order at this time, it will be approved here at Georgetown and you will be added to our email listserv so you will get all future Phi Alpha Theta messages. When that happens, you will get an official "welcome" message from the listserv. At some later point in the year, we will formally initiate you into the society and will present you with your membership certificate.
